Fact File and Surroundings

- At Parwara nestled in the Kumaon Hills between Ramgarh and Mukteshwar.
- 45 kms from Nainital.
- Pantnagar (airport) 95kms; Kathgodam (railway station) 63kms.
- 310 km from Delhi border; 6-7 hrs drive (5hrs to Nainital & almost an hr 15 min to WILDFLOWER HILLS)
- Excellent road recently re-laid and widened. NH 24 widened also almost complete to 4-6 lanes up to Moradabad Bypass and beyond, which would cut down the driving time by another 45 minutes to an hour.
- Picturesque drive with a view of many well-known snow-clad peaks between Ramgarh and Mukteshwar.
- Approx. 7000 ft above sea level, snows in winter & pleasant weather conditions (0-23 degree Celsius) all round the year.
- Place of adventure, trekking and hiking. Bikers, too, love it!
- Dense and vast pine and oak reserved forests surrounding the area.
- Famous for fruit, also called the fruit-bowl of the Kumaon region.
- Extensive variety of birds and small animals.
- Several popular Spa Resorts, Adventure resorts in the vicinity.

- Closest hospital at Mukteshwar (8-10 km), a new 30 bedded hospital coming up there.
